# Apple Inc. (AAPL)

AAPL hourly, 10 days - the WWDC slide and Friday's late stabilisation



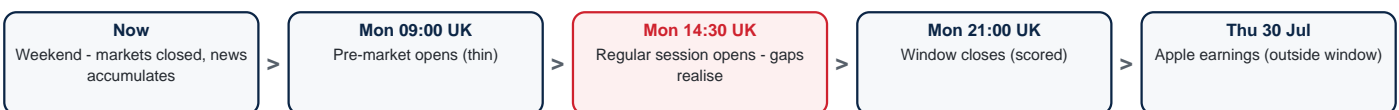
Green dashed line = support. Red dashed line = resistance. Levels are research references, not trade instructions.

- Core thesis:** Apple fell about 5% this week - and 8% from Monday's high - after its WWDC event showed real AI progress but no launch date for the new Siri. The longer-term trend is still up, so this was a sharp re-pricing inside an uptrend, not a broken chart.
- Main catalyst:** any weekend US-Iran outcome lands before Monday's New York open, so the stock can gap at 14:30 UK rather than trade through the news. No Apple-specific events fall inside Monday's session; earnings are July 30.
- Main risk:** if the market keeps cutting its Siri expectations, bounces stay weak - Apple fell on a day the rest of the market rose, and that pattern is the thing to watch.

Base	No decisive weekend news	Chop 288 - 293 around Friday's close	Behaviour near the 292.6 balance area
Bearish	The de-rating continues	Slide toward 287 - 288, stretch 285	Stability on the first test of 288
